

DOWNLOADING CONTENT

For varying reasons, sometimes you might be unable to view videos from Vimeo or Dropbox. We have made both of these options available to meet the needs of all our districts.

The weekly curriculum lessons on our website, stream directly from Vimeo. Our Download Video options takes you to Dropbox.

IF YOUR SCHOOL BLOCKS VIMEO

Use the Download Video button to view the video in Dropbox. You can stream the video directly from Dropbox, Download the video from Dropbox, or copy and paste the Dropbox link to use in your preferred online learning system (Google Class, Schoology, Canvas, etc).

***Please note: Our English and Spanish subtitles are only available on Vimeo. Dropbox does not allow us to transfer the subtitles over to their service.**

IF YOUR SCHOOL BLOCKS DROPBOX

You can stream the curriculum lesson directly from your weekly content page, this is hosted on Vimeo and you can press play directly on the website. DOWNLOADING CONTENT FOR LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS

To download the workbook, press the "Download Workbook" button, which will bring the PDF up in a new window. From there you can either download and save to your computer, or print the page. If you save the file, you will then be able to upload the workbook into the LMS of your choice.

To add the video to your preferred LMS, instead of downloading the full video, we recommend copy and pasting the Dropbox URL from your web browser. This will save you time and computer space from saving the large video files. Step by step instructions are available on the Virtual Learning Resources.
